#### **Pharmaceuticals**

A 25% tariff on drug costs would annually increase costs by

\$51 billion

of generic injectable drugs — like certain

chemotherapy treatments & antibiotics — depend on starter materials in either India or China

### **Medical Supplies**

\$75 billion

worth of medical devices and supplies were imported in 2024,

including syringes, needles, blood pressure cuffs and IV saline bags,

of U.S.-marketed medical devices are manufactured abroad,

In 2023, medical supply expenses cost hospitals nearly \$147 billion 10.5% of total hospital budgets,
